Why did Jesus perform miracles?

- Power to heal
- Power over nature
- Power over demons
- Power to rebuild a body
- Power to create matter
- Power over death
- Power to forgive sin

But is it true...?

- The Jewish leaders hated Jesus...
 - Bad news they didn't believe in Him
 - Good news they tried to prove He was a fake, but were not able to do it
 - > This "test" helps us know that Jesus' miracles were real
- Why did He do these things? What was His important message? (John 20:30-31)
- Why do we have the OT stories? (Colossians 2:17)
- We saw the shadows, now we can see the reality!

Who is Jesus?

- John 1:29-31 He is the Lamb of God
- John 1:49-51 He is the ladder to heaven
- John 2:18-22 He was the temple to be torn down and raised up again
- John 3:14-16 He was <u>lifted up</u> like the snake on the pole (to save dying sinners)
- Our response: Believe

I am the Bread of Life

- John 6:11 Jesus has just created bread and fish, enough to feed 10,000+ people
- John 6:30-31 The people want more physical bread to eat every day
- John 6:32-35 The bread is actually a person, and His name is Jesus
- Our response: Believe

I am the Light of the World

- John 1:1-5 The Word enlightens the world
- **Hebrews 1:3** He is the radiance of God's glory
- John 8:12 He is the light of the World
- John 9:5-7,35-38 Jesus gives sight to the blind
- Our response: Believe

I am the Door and the Good Shepherd

- Psalm 23:1 The Lord is my Shepherd
- John 10:7-9 Jesus is the door of the sheep
- John 10:11,14 He is the good shepherd who dies for His sheep
- Our response: Enter

I am the Resurrection and the Life

- John 11:25-26 Jesus is the resurrection and the life.
- John 11:27 He is the Christ (Messiah), Son of God
- John 11:43-44 Jesus brings a dead man back to life
- Our response: Believe

I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life

- John 14:6 Jesus is the Way, the Truth, and the Life
- John 14:6 Jesus is the only way to the Father
- John 14:7 If you know Jesus, you know the Father
- Our response: Know Him

I am the true Vine

- John 15:1 Jesus is the vine the Father is the gardener
- John 15:5 Only one way to have a fruitful life remain in Him (stay close and connected).
- John 15:10-11 Keep His commandments (John 6:28-29).
- Our response: Believe and Remain

<u>I Am</u>

- Exodus 3:14 The name of God: I Am
- John 8:56-59 Before Moses and Abraham, Jesus existed as "I Am."
- John 10:30-33 Jesus is one with the Father
- John 18:4-6 "I Am" they fall to the ground
- Our response: Worship

The amazing love of God

- Exodus 34:6,7 God is loving and forgiving, but He is just and must punish sin
- To understand God's amazing love (John 3:16), we must see His holiness and justice
- Just like God called out to Adam in the garden, He sent Jesus to die for us and bring us back to Himself
- Believe. Not just to know facts, but a clear understanding of our serious sin problem and complete trust in His sacrifice on the cross for us.

Our great problems - His great solution

 Remember: <u>sin causes death</u> and <u>breaking the law</u> <u>requires punishment</u>. Our two problems are so great that **God became a man** to solve them.

 Mark 10:32-34 – Jesus didn't just come to be the king of a small Jewish nation. He came for a much more important purpose, one with a very high price.
